Opening the Doors for Space Industry

- Poland has joined European Space Agency in 2012
- Supporting Polish Industry development in Space Sector since then:
 - **January 2013**: first workshop with 40 companies, 10 research institutes
 - March 2013: selected first partners for the joint projects
 - April 2014: more advanced projects with same partners and qualified additional ones – over 20 contracts for industrial development and research
 - March 2015: cooperation agreement with Warsaw Technical University to develop technologies for space sector
 - June 2015: Creation of TAS Polska
 - Since 2015: Technology transfer of Composite processes

- Thales Alenia Space in Poland: The demonstrated commitment of a European & International LSI to support the local Polish Space industry in its route to independence, in partnership with Polish Administration and key local industrial players
